Introduction

This post is pivotal to the strategic and operational management of the organisation, providing leadership to the operations team as well as actively contributing to the strategic direction and organisational development, including through cover for colleagues and stepping in for the CEO where needed and appropriate. The role is part of a secondment cover for our current Dep CEO, and is fixed till 31 December 2023.

The role has oversight for ensuring that services are delivered and managed effectively to achieve outcomes for service users and meet the requisite performance indicators. This includes taking the lead for ensuring services operate within quality assurance frameworks and deliver on equality standards, and make improvements as needed. As such, it is the designated lead for EACH's clinical governance work.

Also key to the role is supporting service developments to meet emerging needs or identified gaps, including to support fundraising and business development activities. This entails supporting research and development of evidence based best practice.

The post holder will be a key part of EACH's Senior Leadership Team, and be located at our Ealing Head Office based at 84 Uxbridge Road, West Ealing, W13 8RA, though expected to work across all boroughs as services are both borough and area based. The post holder will be responsible for direct line management of staff – currently operational managers - as well as provide management support and leadership to other staff as needed.

EACH is a voluntary sector organisation with 30 years' experience of providing specialist counselling and support services to individuals and family members affected by alcohol and drug misuse, domestic violence and mental health concerns.

We operate across West London (Brent, Ealing, Hounslow, Harrow and Hillingdon) as well as through outreach-based provision in Kingston-upon-Thames, Richmond, and Wandsworth, Merton, Barnet, Westminster & Chelsea to provide domestic abuse counselling and step down support (mental health). EACH provides a range of community based services, having developed specialist services to meet the needs of BAME communities who experience cultural and linguistic barriers to mainstream services.

Established in 1991, the organisation is recognised both locally and nationally for the innovative work it has pioneered in delivering alcohol and mental health services and therapeutic services in West London.

London Borough of Brent

Brent is located in North-west London and is a borough that is culturally diverse with a significant ethnic population of approximately 57%. Information on the borough can be found on the <u>www.brent.gov.uk</u> website. EACH Brent is located within DesignWorks,

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providing advice, information, domestic violence counselling, Floating Support Services, Young person's substance misuse and mental health services, employment support and mental health counselling.

London Borough of Harrow

The borough is located in North-west London, bordering a number of other London boroughs - Ealing, Brent, Barnet, and Hillingdon – as well as the county of Hertfordshire. London Borough of Hillingdon

EACH currently operates on an outreach basis, delivering adult services on mental health (Tamil community counselling and step down support), employment and domestic violence.

London Borough of Hounslow

Our services are currently provided on an outreach basis and through satellite locations.
